# NOTICE TO MARINERS

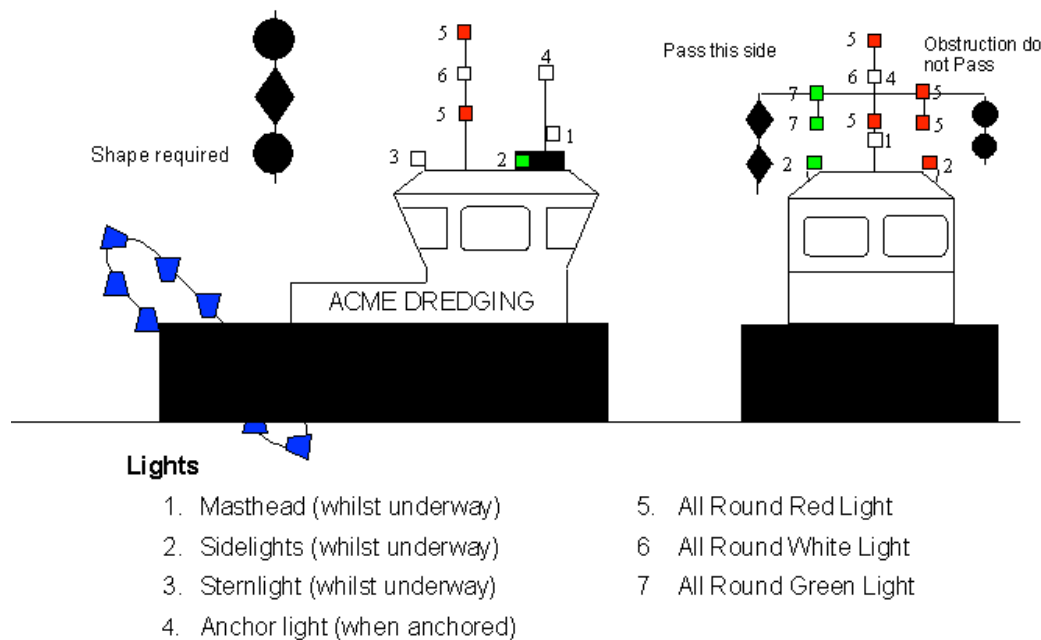
## 21<sup>ST</sup> OCTOBER 2011 - DREDGING

Effective from Monday the 24<sup>th</sup> of October until further notice (approx April 2012) the Dredge “Kikilu” will be operating in the channel and basin of Port Denarau. This operation is for the benefit of all operators and will involve deepening the access channel and marina basin to MLWS depth of 5m.

During this period all vessels are instructed to approach and pass the dredge at a safe speed causing ZERO WAKE. Failure to comply could result in causing serious injury to the dredge operators; therefore infringement of this rule will not be tolerated and will result in the Dredge blocking the channel for the infringing vessel.

All captains are advised to revise their knowledge of RULE 27. A picture of which is shown below for your information.

### Vessels Restricted in their ability to Manoeuvre Dredging or Underwater operations



The Dredge will be operating 24 hour a day and can be contacted on VHF 16 with call sign “Kikilu”.
